Course Title: Stuck in the Middle with You: Middle Leadership Teacher CPD

About this course:

This course is aimed at middle leaders or aspiring middle leaders in school or college settings. It aims to provide an opportunity for staff to prepare for leadership or to reflect on where they are at in their leadership journey thus far. It will provide a safe space to talk honestly about the joys and frustrations; learn from the presenter and each other about how some of the challenges can be met.

You will gain:

- Understanding different leadership styles and theories of motivation

Session Outlines

A typical event would be divided into 4 sessions – either half day or full day. The programme below is given as an example

Session 1: Who wants to drive? What reasons are there to choose leadership? Different leadership styles: the good, the bad and the ugly. What is your leadership SHAPE?

Session 2: Where are we going? Establishing a vision, the importance of values. The tension between dreams and reality

Session 3: Taking people with you Understanding people and what makes them tick. Theories of motivation. Power vs influence, compliance vs engagement. What about 'difficult people?' Managing upwards and downwards.

Session 4: Measuring Progress How well are things going? How do you know? Quality Assurance and Quality Improvement. Feedback loops.

Delivery Options

Full day, half day or twilight options are available where a half day or twilight covers some of the above by agreement.
