Course Title: GCSE Religious Studies – Student day/conference

About this event:

This event is aimed at students who are taking GCSE Religious Studies. It may also be of interest to those who are about to take the course or serve as an introduction. The event will provide stimulating talks on several different areas of the specification as well as a session on exam technique.

Students will gain:

- Understanding of several different topics from different aspects of the course.
- High quality resources including lecture notes and PowerPoint slides.
- Understanding of what examiners look for in GCSE level RS answers.

Session Outlines

A typical full day event would be divided into 4 sessions. The programme below is given as an example – other topics/titles could be delivered on request

Session 1: Christianity crash course: starting at Jesus and including a number of questions that you have been afraid to ask, a deeper look at the Bible and how Christians understand it, why there are different groups of Christians?

Session 2: Can God be proved? What is Philosophical method and how much do religious believers value it? How do the different arguments for the existence of God work? Which if any is best?

Session 3: Meet the Examiner: a look at what makes for good exam technique and a chance to practice being the examiner on some sample answers. What makes for good revision?

Session 4: Faith and Moral Issues: looking through a moral issue from the perspective of faith. Why do believers think the way they do on this issue?

Delivery Options

All schools are different in terms of available time. Full day, half day or even twilight options are available where a half day or twilight covers some of the above by agreement. Equally a more bespoke package tailored to the needs of the school can be delivered as required. The above package can be delivered online if this is preferred or in the event of face to face delivery not being possible.
